- * Rebate checks will be issued within three (3) to six (6) weeks of issuance of Rebate Confirmation Notice.

7. Rebate Program Terms

Important! Please read and review the following program guidelines and other important information carefully:

- * I understand participants are limited to receiving a one-time rebate per household
- * I understand that rebates will be processed in the order they are received, and that this offer is limited by available funding. I further understand that processing of my rebate may take between three (3) to six (6) weeks following the District issuance of Rebate Confirmation Notice
- * I understand the program will reimburse me for \$75 of the cost of the toilet. Installation costs are not covered.
- * I understand that the toilet must be new and meet qualifying criteria. I further understand that the qualified machine must be purchased and installed at the address listed after January 1, 2010.
- * Toilets must be installed at a private residence, rebates will not be issued for toilets installed in multi-family complexes.
- * I understand that any toilet, for which a rebate is issued, is subject to an on-site installation verification. If installation cannot be verified, the rebate will be denied.
- * The Internal Revenue Service requires Rebate Program participants receiving \$600 or more in rebates to be issued an IRS Form 1099.
- * The Rebate Program is not responsible for materials lost by mail
- * This project was undertaken in connection with the settlement of an enforcement action taken by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment for alleged violations of the Colorado Water Quality Control Act. The Stonegate Village Metropolitan District takes the alleged violations related to the treatment and discharge of wastewater to Cherry Creek very seriously and believes that residents of the District will benefit from and are committed to protecting the water quality of Cherry Creek and the environment.

- A valid Colorado driver's license;
Note: The Colorado Department of Revenue will allow us to accept a driver's license from the District of Columbia or any of the following 33 states: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Virginia, West Virginia, or Wyoming;
- A valid Colorado identification card;
- A United States Military card;
- A United States military dependent's identification card;
- A United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;
- A Native American tribal document; a birth certificate issued by a state, county or parish;
- A naturalization or citizenship certificate;
- A court-issued adoption order
- An unexpired foreign passport;
- An I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or
- An unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card.

In addition, you must sign an affidavit stating either: (1) you are a United States citizen; or (2) you are a legal permanent resident of the United States; or (3) you are otherwise lawfully present in the United States pursuant to federal law. A Blank affidavit is attached for your convenience.

Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork.
