

## **An Update for the Residents of Stonegate Village**

The Stonegate Village Metropolitan District's purpose is to ensure quality water and reliable wastewater services for the community, protection of the environment and help maintain property values.

One of the challenges that Board and residents face, is the existing non-renewable water supply (well water) is not sustainable over the long term.

Therefore, in its ongoing quest to provide a renewable water supply to its customers, the District's Board has been working diligently to identify the most cost-efficient solutions to replace about 65% of the community's existing non-renewable water supply.

Currently the Board is reviewing all viable options such as upgrading existing infrastructure, purchasing renewable water and/or affiliating with local water providers, like Parker Water and South Metro Water Supply Authority. The District's Board members have been carefully evaluating these options for sustainable water and reliable wastewater services. They will present their findings in 2011.
