On July 2, 2024, the District requested assistance regarding ongoing trespassing issues at the pond. Unfortunately, this continues to be a persistent problem. While the Douglas County Sheriff's Office has issued numerous citations to individuals violating the no trespassing rules, the activity has not ceased.

We have identified that many trespassers are discovering the pond through a fishing application, with a significant number coming from outside the Stonegate community.

To protect District property and ensure the health, safety, and welfare of our residents, taxpayers, and constituents, we must reiterate that fishing and all water-related activities are strictly prohibited on all District-owned properties, including the District Reservoir. Please note that the reservoir contains reclaimed wastewater and is not intended for recreational use of any kind.

If these violations continue, the District will have no choice but to implement additional deterrents, including the installation of chain-link fencing with barbed wire.

The District has formally requested increased patrols from the Douglas County Sheriff's Office. We strongly encourage residents to report any trespassing activity directly by calling the non-emergency line at 303-660-7505 if you observe individuals violating these regulations.

Thank you for your cooperation and assistance in helping maintain the safety and integrity of District properties.
